Senate concurs with House changes to SB 268 - bill now heads to the Governor

As a follow-up to our communications on SB 268, we want to report that during this morning's floor session, the Senate agreed to the House changes to the bill and passed it by a <u>vote of 26-6</u>. This bill now has completed legislative action and is headed to the Governor's desk for his signature. The WVHA will be submitting a support letter to the Governor and would encourage hospital leadership to do the same. Key points to make are highlighted in our <u>March 3rd Op/Ed</u> that was distributed to statewide media. Send support letters to:

SB 268 provides for a series of comprehensive changes to the Public Employees Insurance Agency (PEIA). The key provisions for hospitals were retained in the bill. They increase PEIA inpatient rates effective July 1, 2023, to 110% of Medicare, including language clarifying this rate also applies to critical access hospitals per diem, per day rate.
