SAR Training Courses

The Nationwide SAR Initiative (NSI) is a multifaceted approach designed to increase the effectiveness of state, local, tribal, and territorial (SLTT) law enforcement and public safety professionals and other frontline partners in identifying, reporting, evaluating, and sharing per-incident terrorism indicators to prevent acts of terrorism. This training teaches how to identify behaviors and indicators that may indicate terrorism-related criminal activity and

how to report identified suspicious activity to the proper authorities while maintaining the protection of citizens' privacy, civil rights, and civil liberties. <u>Take the courses</u>
