Public Safety UAS Drones for First Responders

November 3-5, 2025

Bridgeport

This 24-hour course prepares participants to establish or enhance a UAS program and sit for the FAA Part 107 remote pilot exam. In addition, this course will cover West Virginia specific drone laws and sectional chart reading. [Flyer](#)

Human Trafficking During Disasters

November 13, 2025

Morgantown, WV

participants will learn how to apply the SOAR Framework to identify and respond to trafficking and discuss elements of trauma informed care and will explore how disasters and emergencies can increase risk of human trafficking and learn actionable strategies to prevent and respond to trafficking during all phases of disaster management.

Technician Modular Emergency Response Radiological Transportation Training (TMERRTT)

Dec. 1-3, 2025

Huntington, WV

This 8-hour course incorporates the use of high activity "live" radiation sources. This radiological hazard technician level training program is aligned with specific radiological competencies listed in NFPA 472 for a technician level and agent specific responder. ICS-300 Intermediate Incident Command

Dec. 2-4, 2025

Morgantown, WV

This course builds on ICS 100 and 200 by teaching supervisors how to manage incidents that grow beyond their initial scope. It focuses on the National Incident Management System (NIMS) Command and Management components.

ICS-400 Advanced Incident Command System for Complex Incidents

This advanced course is for senior emergency personnel who are expected to manage complex incidents. It expands on the information learned from ICS-110, 200, and 300. It covers large-scale organization development, roles, and relationships within command and general staff, and planning, operational, logistical, and fiscal consideration for major events. MGT-318 Public Information in An All-Hazards Incident

Designed for participants whose duties may require them to interface with news media representatives during their community's response to a WMD/terrorism incident or major disaster. This course examines the role of public information in managing an all-hazards incident and provides practical training in crisis communication techniques.

In 2024, the FBI designated 24 active shooter incidents in the United States, a 50% decrease from 2023 (48). There were 106 casualties (23 killed and 83 wounded), a 57% decrease from 2023 (244). [Learn More](#)
